

City of Scarville Minutes for February 5, 2024

The City Council met in regular session at City Hall on February 5, 2024. Mayor Harmon called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Present at roll call were Council members Orlyn Rosen, Carla Langfald, Guy Langfald Mayor Harmon, and City Clerk Mary Faulkner. Absent: Lynn Sanden, Cory Mathahs

Moved by Carla Langfald, seconded by Orlyn Rosen to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Moved by Guy Langfald, seconded by Orlyn Rosen to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Motion carried.

Bills were reviewed. A motion by Orlyn Rosen was seconded by Carla Langfald to approve the payment of the following list of bills. Motion carried.

Mayor Harmon brought to the council the bids for the Fire Hall Construction. The first bid was for the plumbing and heating. There was only 1 bid provided and that was by Young Plumbing and heating Guy entered a motion to except this bid, Orlyn seconded it and all were in favor. The next bid was for Wains coating around the outside of the buildings and insulation removal. This bid was provided by Larson Contracting. Guy entered a motion to except and Carla seconded, all were in favor. The next bid was for cement for the approach. There were 2 bids that were very close to each other. Orlyn entered a motion to except the bid from Rygh and Guy seconded, all in favor. The final item that was bid on was the septic system. Carla entered a motion to except the bid from LM Pump and Guy seconded it. All were in favor. Mayor Harmon will contact the vendors.

Mayor Harmon talked to young plumbing and heating about ventilation in the building for the fire station and also has been talking with the state to get approval for the new well. He said the probable location will be in the park in the area of the merry go round.

Greg Schreb stop by and was providing information on the tanks and piping. Asked about the funds to pay for this and the Mayor and council said that the will be paid from the funds that are currently from the donation funds that are in MBT bank.

The mayor gave an update on the Coffee Tree Group. More to come

Final thing on the Agenda was the review for the City Clerk. Carla entered a motion to increase the city clerk's wage by 3 dollars and hour to \$25. Guy seconded and all were in favor.
