She requested some funds to donation for the fireworks. Also they would like to block off the street south of the Scarville bar for bag throwing. Moved by Corey and seconded by Lynn all in favor to donate 500.00 to the Booster Club. Also for the 4th of July Corey is going to put up the flags in town and Lynn will help with the cones during the parade.

A motion was made by Lynn and seconded by Guy to accept the amendment for the 23-24 all in favor. A motion by Carla and seconded by Guy to accept the 24-25 budget, all were in favor.
