The City Council met in regular session at City Hall on November 4, 2024. Mayor Harmon called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

The first thing on the Agenda was approving the AFR report. This is information that is uploaded by the city clerk to the State of Iowa. It shows what the city is spending their funds on. Next the city clerk requested the approval of the 1st installment of the remodel to be made from TIF funds. The payment is due December 1st.

Nick Bloedel came in with new blue prints and requested that the building permit be extended to a year because we are approaching winter time and the weather can be a factor in when he is complete. He also requested a sewer system and water to be run from the new well. The council voted and it was approved for all 3 items.

Todd Hanson came in with a bid for snow removal for the 24 – 25 winter season. The council voted and approve to accept his bid.

Councilman Mathahs is also on the fire department and mention the pumper truck needed some repairs done so there will be a bill coming for that and there is a leak in the bathroom at the Fire Hall. Mayor Harmon will look in to that. City clerk will have to amend the budget for this expense.

Mayor Harmon talked to The Coffee Tree group to see if they are still planning on coming to Scarville to set up business and they said that they are. They just have some more things to work out.
