The City Council met in regular session at City Hall on December 1, 2025. Mayor Harmon called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Present at roll call were Council members Guy Langfald, Matt Leuwerke, Cory Mathahs and City Clerk Mary Faulkner.

Moved by Guy Langfald, seconded by Cory Mathahs, to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Moved by Matt Leuwerke, seconded by Guy Langfald to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Motion carried.

The city clerk swore in the 2 new council members and Mayor beginning Jan 1, 2026. She also requested the council approve the update made at MBT Bank for Doug Harmon to be removed as a signer and have Cory Mathahs added as a signer. The council voted and all were in favor.

Nick Bloedel came in with more concerns and stated that he was not ready to hand in his building permit because of the turn in the weather conditions. Also, he said that he has a concern that one of the council people cannot be impartial and thinks they should recuse themselves from any voting where he is concerned.

The next discussion was on the snow removal for the first snow fall. Some of the residents voiced their concern to Matt and Mayor Harmon suggested that the residents be patient as this is the time for this company and if they have an issue to voice it to them as that is the only way that they will be made aware.

Mayor Harmon requested that the city council consider a pay increase for the City Clerk. This usually takes place in March, and it was missed. The suggested raise was \$1.50 and hr. The council voted and all were in favor.

The city clerk will be posting a sign saying that the city will be taking bids for a new cleaning person for the Community Center and bathrooms in the park.

This is the final meeting for Mayor Harmon. He has done a lot for the town since becoming Mayor and he will be missed.

There being no further business, a motion by Matt Leuwerke was seconded by Guy Langfald to adjourn at 7:38 p.m. Motion carried.
