

City of Scarville Minutes for February 2, 2026

The City Council met in regular session at City Hall on February 2, 2026. Mayor Cory Mathahs called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Present at roll call were Council members Carla Langfald, Guy Langfald, Matt Leuwerke and City Clerk Mary Faulkner.

Moved by Carla Langfald, seconded by Matt Leuwerke, to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Moved by Matt Leuwerke, seconded by Guy Langfald to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Motion carried.

Bills were reviewed. A motion by Matt Leuwerke was seconded by Carla Langfald to approve the payment of the following list of bills. Motion carried.

First item on the agenda was quotes for a new Scarville sign. Matt had received 2 quotes. This is going to be voted on at a later date when it gets warmer.

Then the city clerk brought up the renewal of the CD. The city clerk has done a calculation as to the funds that are needed before the next tax payment is received. With the extra cost of heating and snow removal it was decided by the council to roll \$25,000 back into the CD and then the balance to going to the general fund account for now. Moved by Carla Langfald, seconded by Matt Leuwerke, all were in favor.

The mayor let everyone know that there will be an invoice from Groe Electric for the new fire station coming in. They were requested to replace the sensor for the lights to a switch that can be shut off.

Carla Langfald has brought requesting control arms be added to the railroad tracks at the south end of town. There had been a near miss there and she was very concerned. Matt Leuwerke said he would find out who to contact and then request arms be added.

Mayor Mathahs talked a little bit about what he had learned at the most recent Win Worth Betco meeting. It was about Iowa Home Development for affordable housing. Possibly more to come on this.
