

City of Scarville Minutes for June 1, 2026

The City Council met in regular session at City Hall on June 1, 2026. Mayor Cory Mathahs called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Present at roll call were Council members Lynn Sanden, Carla Langfald (phone), Guy Langfald, Matt Leuwerke and City Clerk Mary Faulkner.

Moved by Guy Langfald, seconded by Lynn Sanden, to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Moved by Matt Leuwerke, seconded by Guy Langfald to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Motion carried.

One of the Scarville residents was asking about spraying the weeds in the streets and getting water from the park. The mayor and council agreed that the weeds are a part of the contract with Turf Trimmers and he could get water by the bucket if he needed. The city clerk is going to call and request the Port A Pots, Matt is going to call on getting a dumpster, Cory is going to call someone for mosquito spraying and Lynn is going to take care of the street cones for the parade. Mayor Mathahs reviewed with the council about what information he received from the insurance company. He has been in contact with someone that is willing to remove the old fire station garage and cement hopefully before the 4th of July. More to come on this! The city clerk will let everyone aware when the insurance check arrives.

Guy Langfald brought up a concern about the building permit that was left by The Coffee Tree Group at our May meeting. There was some discussion on that and it was decided that we would wait and see if they would come to our July meeting to discuss the concerns. Mayor Mathahs is going to talk to Rogness brothers to see if they have any info on the old school house burial.
